Compensation for Public Officers who suffer injury whilst on duty

Your attention is drawn to Public Administration Circular 22/93 dated 21.09.1993 on the above matter and all the circulars issued as revisions to the above circular.

02. The Cabinet of Ministers has decided at its meeting held on 18.07.2017 that, at instances where a public officer demises whilst on duty due to accidents that take place only at the following occasions, which are mentioned in Public Administration Circular 22/93 (III) dated 04.05.2005, issued as a revision to Public Administration Circular 22/93, the relevant officer shall be promoted from the Grade held at the time of death, to the next higher Grade from the date of his/her death.

- i. While on duty
- ii. Not on duty, but while performing any act within the scope of duty
- iii. As a consequence of any act performed in the execution of duty
- iv. While proceeding from the place of work, on duty, or while returning to the place of work.

03. These promotions shall be applied only to the Graded Promotions.

04. The provisions of this circular shall be effective from 18.07.2017.
